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### **PARK CITY HOSTS SEMINAR ON GAMBLING, RAFFLES AND DABC RULES FOR NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS ON WEDNESDAY, APRIL 14**

Is your nonprofit thinking about including a raffle as part of your next fund raiser? Confused about state liquor laws and what kind of local and state permits you might need? On Wednesday, April 14, Park City Municipal is hosting a free seminar to help nonprofit organizations understand Utah gambling and liquor laws. The Park City Attorney's Office, Park City Special Events staff, and representatives from the State Division of Alcohol and Beverage Control (DABC) and the Summit County Attorney's Office will provide information and answer questions to assist your organization successfully navigate state and local regulations.

The workshop will be held Wednesday, April 14 at 11:15 am in Room 205 of the Park City Library and Education Center located at 1255 Park Avenue. The meeting is open to the public and free of charge. No advance registration is required.

Park City Attorney Mark Harrington described the workshop as an *"effort to educate area non-profits who may be concerned about the enforcement Utah gambling and liquor laws and to allow an opportunity for questions and further clarification."* An informational handout of frequently asked questions will be available at the meeting.

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
